Instructions for Applicants, PE Exams in 2026

Please read following the instructions for PE Exam carefully, and submit your application.

◇[Qualification for PE Exam Applicants]

- Those who reside in Japan, and have graduated from Universities in Japan or in the USA with four-year education. You should have a degree of Bachelor of Engineering, or Bachelor of Science in Engineering. You should also have Japanese Pension No. (JPN), or Social Security No. (SSN) in USA. You do not have to hold Japanese Citizenship. (If you have any doubts regarding your degree, please contact your graduated University for confirmation.)
- Those who have Master of Engineering or Doctor of Engineering in Japan or USA are also eligible to take the PE Exam.
- Those people, who have graduated Universities other than in Japan or USA, please contact JPEC Office prior to the application regarding the qualification.
- You should have passed the FE Exam.
- You do not have to have more than four years of professional experience to take the exam.

Upon JPEC's approval on FE exam, registration for NCEES's account [My NCEES] and application of the exam date to VUE Test Center will be done at any time, and you may change the actual date for the exam at this stage. Registration to NCEES's account is valid only one year after your registration, and you have to take the exam within one year after the registration. If you register NCEES's account before JPEC approval, you may face difficulties due to limited time available for the exam. Therefore, please register NCEES's account only after JPEC approval.

= How to apply PE Exam =

Exam application shall be in accordance with the following steps.

1: From the Application to the Exam

- 1) **Application:** The applicants shall pay the application fee in accordance with the Item 2 below, then send the necessary documents to JPEC by post.
- 2) **Review the Application Documents by JPEC:** JPEC will review the Application Documents in accordance with the NCEES/JPEC's criterion, and then decide whether the applicants are eligible to take the Examination.
- 3) **Inform the results of the review to the Applicants:** JPEC will inform the results of the review by post within 3-5 weeks depends on the number of applicants and review procedure.
- 4) **Web Application to NCEES:** Once accepted by JPEC, the applicants shall access NCEES Website (<http://ncees.org/>), and register necessary information through [My NCEES] page.

At the end of the registration, the Applicants are requested to pay the exam fee directly to NCEES by credit card. After the registration and payment to NCEES, JPEC will be able to give final approval to the applicants. Only after the JPEC's final approval, the applicants can make booking of the exam site (Pearson VUE), and exam date, therefore please wait for approx. one week before the booking. Please refer to the NCEES Examinee Guide for details.

The applicants may change the exam date through this Web site.

Important Note: The applicants are not supposed to register the NCEES Web site before getting JPEC's approval, since this may cause serious problems.

- 5) **Data confirmation between JPEC and NCEES:** After confirming the applicant's data, email will be sent to the applicants.
- 6) **FE Exam:** The applicant shall take the FE CBT Exam in accordance with their booking.
- 7) **Confirmation of Pass/Fail:** After approx. two weeks from the Exam, the applicants may receive email from NCEES, and the applicants are requested to find Pass/Fail status on their [My NCEES] screen of NCEES home page.

In case of re-taking the Exam, all the sequence from 1) above shall be observed.

2: PE Exam Fee

In order to take PE Exam, following two kinds of fees shall be paid. These fees are applicable in case of retaking the exam.

- 1) Application fee (by Postal Transfer)

The Application fee will not be refundable after approval of the Application regardless of its reason including cancellation or no-show. However, in case that the applicants are not eligible to take the exam as a result of JPEC's review, the above application fee will be refunded.

2) Exam Fee (by Credit Card)

During the registration process of NCEES's Web site, please pay US\$ 425 directly to NCEES by MasterCard or Visa card.

The Exam fee will be refundable with several conditions, please check the details with NCEES Examinee Guide (<http://ncees.org/exams/cbt/examinee-guide/>).

If you submit it together with the application for the examination, JPEC will give you advice on how to write it as needed, so we recommend that you submit it to JPEC for review and comments.

== Important Notice to the Applicants ==

1. After receiving the application by JPEC, review will be carried out, and then the approval will be given. Then the Web registration to NCEES is required.
2. Only an English Signature is acceptable.
Signature shall be by the applicants themselves, and shall be the same signature when you take the Exam. Signature with block letters is not acceptable.
3. Please write First Name, Middle Initial (If applicable), Last Name (Ex. : TARO, J, SUZUKI,)
4. Please bring official photo ID with your signature to the Exam site, such as a Passport in accordance with the requirement of NCEES/Pearson VUE to confirm the applicant's ID. Without this, you cannot enter the Exam site.
5. [Important] There are strict regulations regarding the electronic calculators to be used in the Exam site, and some changes may be expected. Please check and confirm JPEC home page "<http://www.jpec2002.org>" at any time.

6. Once your exam date reservation with Pearson VUE is completed, you will receive a confirmation email from Pearson VUE. This recommendable email contains instructions and important information. Please read it carefully and follow the guidelines provided.
7. JPEC cannot access any information regarding candidates who have booked exams at the Pearson VUE test site. For inquiries related to exam reservation procedures, schedule changes, candidate verification on the exam day, or any other matters concerning the Pearson VUE test site, please contact Pearson VUE directly.

== Information on NCEES Certificate after passing the PE Exam ==

After passing the FE & PE Exams, no certificate will be issued from NCEES (National Council of Examiners for Engineering and Surveying), however, the record is kept within NCEES.

If you wish to work in the USA as a Professional Engineer, you are required to register at a certain State in USA by your own effort to get P.E. License. (License will be issued by each State, and renewed as required.) NCEES will provide the result of the exam to that State that you are passing the Exams in Japan. Then the Examination Council of that State will start reviewing your records. This will require only document review, and no further Exams will be required except special situations.

Each State Council has its own standard of qualification, and they check applicants' academic record, professional experiences, and references, etc. Even though you have passed the PE Exam, some State Councils may reject your application because of academic compatibility is not in accordance with the accreditation of ABET, or lack of academic credit and etc. Therefore, there may be some cases that you may not be able to register your P.E. License at your designated State due to compatibility problems.

In any case, JPEC is not in a position to bear any responsibilities if your registration application will be rejected. Requirements of each State are different and totally depend on the State, you are encouraged to contact the Examination Council of the State beforehand. You can find Examination Councils of States through the NCEES home page (http://www.ncees.org/Licensing_boards.php).

Please note that passing the PE exam and P.E. License are quite different, and you are not supposed to act as licensed P.E. nor doing the job as P.E. only with the pass of the PE exam.
